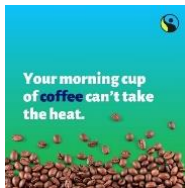
Farmers and workers cannot be left alone in a climate crisis they did not cause. Climate change has a huge impact on farming communities and the commodities they grow.



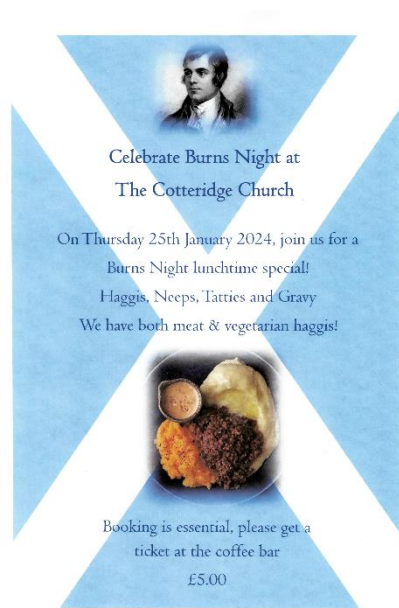
Climate change is having a significant impact on banana production - the impact of climate change on banana farming has already caused banana production to decline by up to 50% in some from the regions.

Cocoa is a delicate crop that requires specific climatic conditions to thrive, but rising temperatures, changes in rainfall patterns, and more extreme weather events are making it increasingly difficult to grow.

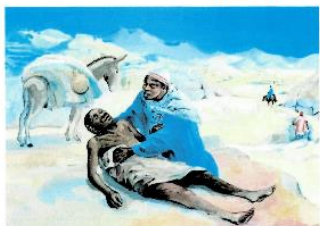
