Friends Meeting House 23aWatford Road B30
1JB** on Tuesday and Friday between 1.30 and
3.30pm.

Last week

On Tuesday we fed 45 people (25 adults
20children) on 18 vouchers.

On Friday we fed 81 people (44 adults
37children) on 31 vouchers.

We used 935 kilograms of food and received in
donations 2147kgs.
