Changes to Congregational Giving

Over the last year there have been a lot of changes to the running of the Cotteridge Church's finances. One of the most important ones is the way our members give to the church. Last October we changed to using a Direct Debit scheme (which is more secure than Standing Orders) through the Parish Giving Scheme which also claims the Gift Aid directly for us. This is particularly important because we no longer have anyone able to make the claim. A heartfelt thank you to everyone who has made the change. I would also appeal to members who haven't yet changed, because it will cost the church almost £600 a month in lost Gift Aid if you don't.
