Urgently needed

UHT whole milk, tinned spaghetti, pasta shapes, rice (500g), tinned/carton instant custard. chocolate bars, jam/honey, long-life fruit juice (not needing refrigeration), tinned rice pudding, small jars instant coffee (not decaffeinated), instant noodles, sweet biscuits (not multipacks, as they often have no ingredients listed on the packs inside), liquid/bar soap, toothpaste, size 5& 6 nappies
