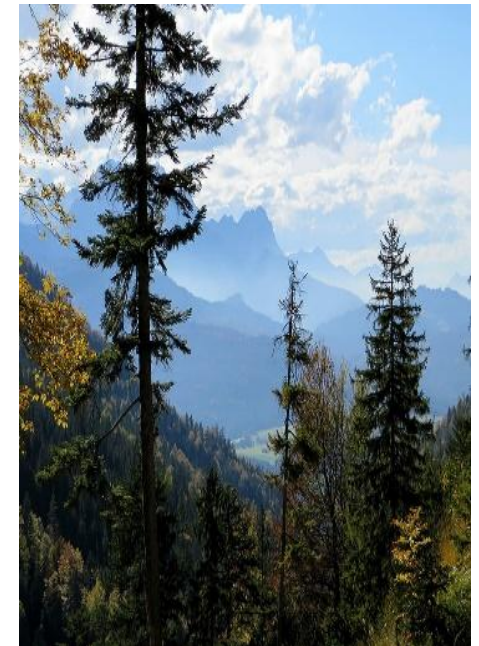

inside), liquid/bar soap, toothpaste,
size 5& 6 nappies
